ABSOLUTELY NO PHONE ENTRIES OR WALK-INS will be considered. Please send applications in team lots if possible.

Application MUST be read and signed at spaces noted or application is void. This form may be duplicated.

- 1. Entry fee covers entry requirements and insurance. Fee is \$35.00
- 2. A wrestler's age group classification is determined by his/her age on December 31. EXAMPLE: A wrestler's 11<sup>th</sup> birthday is 1/1/2024. That wrestler competes in the 9 & 10 division because he was 10 on December 31, 2023.
- 3. P.I.A.A. rules will govern all matches, except as modified by PJW.
- 4. All bouts for 8U and 10u will consist of three periods of 1 1 1 minutes, overtime will be 1 minute, then :30 ride out if needed.
- 5. All Championship bouts for 12u will consist of periods of 1:30 1 1 minutes, and ll consolation bouts for 12un will consist of three periods of 1 1 1 minutes. Overtime for all bouts will be 1 minute, then :30 ride out if needed.
- 6. Headgear is required in all PJW Tournaments. HEADGEARS MUST BE WORN AS SPECIFIED BY MANUF. (NO CROSSED STRAPS)
- 7. The PIAA shoelace rule will be enforced. Please be prepared to secure or tape shoelaces
- 8. Participants must weigh in at the weight class they have entered. There will be no shifting of weights or substitutions at weigh-in time. Entrants not making weight will be scratched. Weigh-in will be required only once for each tournament.
- 9. A wrestler cannot wrestle outside his/her age group and may enter in one weight class only. Exception: a wrestler exceeding the limit for the last weight class in 8 & U or 9 &10 may enter the appropriate weight class in the next higher age group.
- 10. Copies of birth certificates will be required of all participants at the Area Tournament, and for all wrestlers competing in the State Championship Tournament and must be presented at weigh-ins.
- 11. The source of rules governing this tournament will be the P.I.A.A. Rule Book, the Pennsylvania Junior Wrestling Rules Booklet, and the Area Rules that apply to the operation of the qualifying tournament.
- 12. Only full-time residents of Pennsylvania may enter the Pennsylvania Junior Wrestling tournaments.
- 13. The application form and the code of conduct form must be completed entirely for an applicant to be considered for entry to the PJW tournament.
- 14. The NFHS undergarment rule will be applied. All contestants must weigh in wearing a singlet.
- 15. The PIAA mouthpiece rule will be enforced this year. You must wear a mouthpiece to cover any braces. Upper and lower braces must be covered with a moutpiece.
